 - Determine what additional research needs to be done and select which area of research the Fiber Council would like to focus on funding

Education/Communication

- Review and fiber statistics that are on OTA site
 - This is an annual process that takes place at the Spring meeting.
- Create an Organic Textiles 101 Pamphlet
 - Similar to the existing OTA <u>Organic 101 pamphlet</u> but with a focus on fiber
- Hold a public event to educate consumers on the benefits of organic fiber and textiles
- Hold a joint TE-OTA-GOTS webinar on the benefits of certified organic fiber products
