Raw organic and non-organic cotton are physically separated and machines are cleaned before ginning, spinning, milling, dying, or sewing begins. Only Global Organic Textile Standard (GOTS) approved inputs are permitted in any/each stage of processing. Finished Certified Organic Products are labeled according to GOTS requirements.

The GLOBAL ORGANIC TEXTILE STANDARD (GOTS) defines requirements to ensure the organic status of textiles, from harvesting of the raw materials, through environmentally and socially responsible manufacturing up to labeling in order to provide a credible assurance to the end consumer. GOTS defines high-level environmental

criteria along the entire organic textiles supply chain and also requires compliance with social criteria.
