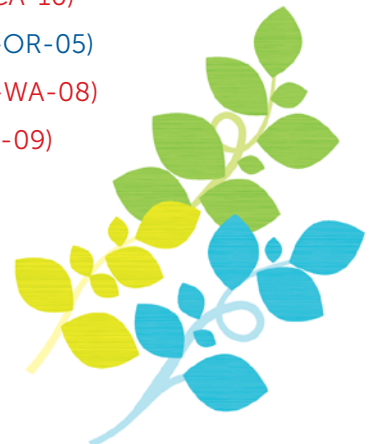




## Top Fifty Districts with Certified Organic Operations
